

This year FPS will again participate in the Santa's Helpers Program by having interested members of the congregation purchase a specific gift for a child in need. The program has grown into a non-profit organization which partners with the L-5 School District to provide Christmas for over 100 needy families. Our congregation joined this effort in 2011 and has purchased over 900 toys for children of needy families in our area since our participation began. To play a part in this valuable program all you need to do is:

Gifts do not need to be wrapped; all wrapping will be done by the Santa's Helpers organization.




